Ian reported that he was re-elected as Registrar for NSW at a recent judges' meeting.

Supper was served.

#### Speaker

Joe Gafa gave us a run-down on how he grows his orchids. His main points were that for successful growing you need to find the best aspect for each particular orchid. He spends much time moving his orchids about as the seasons change. He has a heated greenhouse plus several shade houses and does a lot of hand-watering. He uses a high nitrogen fertiliser in spring and one high in potassium in February. He does not feed much in winter. For the very hot weather he has sprinklers under the benches and for cold weather he has a heater in his glasshouse. The mix he uses is bark with a layer of foam for drainage. Joe feels that through trial and error and moving his orchids about over the seasons he has hit on the right formula for his particular growing area. The audience was most appreciative of his explanation on how he grows his magnificent plants.
